Number plate FAQ's UK ONLY

1. Do I need an Supplier ID (SID, previously known as RNPS) number?

Yes, an SID number is required to legally produce and supply license plates in the UK.

2. Do I need to show my local branch my registration documents for the plates?

No, you don't need to show your local branch this, the responsibility to record sits with you.

3. Can I have my garage details on the plate?

Yes, we can create a template to set up your garage details on the plates.

4. What type of plates do you supply?

- Standard plates (520x111) in a plain format
- We also offer options for plates with green EV/UK/Wales/Scotland flags
- Additionally, we provide motorcycle plates and import square plates, which are available for same-day delivery at selected branches
- For bespoke sizes (e.g., JLR), speak to your local branch.

5. Do you offer fitting kits?

Yes, we provide fitting kits. We also offer large packs of fittings and sticky pads should you need more.

6. Can I have my own printer?

If you print 250+ pair per month, your own printer is a more economical choice. Contact your Account Manager for more details.

7. If I get my own printer installed, what are the operational costs involved?

The main operational cost to consider is the replacement ribbon, which is needed after printing approximately 550 plates (3p per plate).
